

SUMMER CAMP 2022 PATCH INSTRUCTIONS

Makes a 3.25 x 3.56" patch

MATERIALS:

Water Soluble Non Woven Stabilizer

Temporary Spray Adhesive like KK 2000

Patch Fabric: A poly twill will be best. I used Poly Patch Twill (in tan). If you don't want to go this route, I would use a poly twill, and iron on a heavy stabilizer or interfacing; this will assist in keeping the patch from fraying.

Use a 75/11 or 65/9 needle - with the letters, make sure it's a new needle, and slow down your machine to the slowest speed.

For best results, you'll want to use bobbin thread (60 wt) for the letters.

1. Hoop water soluble stabilizer.
2. Run placement stitch.
3. Cut the patch material slightly smaller than the placement stitch. You should be able to see around the placement stitch. Spray the back of the patch fabric, and place over the placement stitch.
3. Run the border stitch.
4. Change colors to the bear color, and run this step.
5. Change color to the bear border.
6. Change colors if desired to the letter stitches, then run. For best results with the letters, choose a contrasting color. After many tests, I decided I preferred the cream color with the brown patch fabric. Also, I found that I had the cleanest stitches when I used bobbin thread for the letters.
7. Remove from hoop and wash away the stabilizer.
8. Enjoy!

Use this as your template, not necessarily your color choices ;) Remember to cut your fabric a bit smaller than this template.
