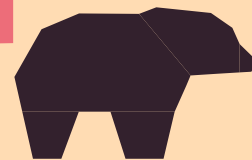

# NATIONAL PARK SUMMER CAMP

*cultivate your inner artist*



This summer we will explore color and all of its angles. Consider pulling these fabrics in advance, or keep this sheet with you while you shop for fabrics - you might stumble upon the perfect rosey pink, or the cheeriest lemon yellow! You won't need to much of each of these colors, so if you are purchasing, don't get more than a fat quarter!

Normally, I use the Moda "My Favorite Color Is Moda" panel, but there were several colors missing, so I've opted for Kona colors. You can take this sheet with you, or you can look them up online. Search "Kona Name Number". DO NOT use the printed colors as your guide - they are incorrect. They must be the actual color.

If you have used my patterns, you know I'm a huge fan of similars. For Summer Camp, I want you to embrace this color palette as it is. I've designed the activities to help you see color in different ways, and grow your creative muscle.

All of the details on the swatches, and how to use them, will be in the Activity Guide. For now, I want you to rummage through your fabrics pull these color out, and get comfy with them :)



Print the iron on patches on the next page, or stitch out an embroidered patch if you have an embroidery machine (or have someone with a machine embroider it for you! Iron on: I use Jet Pro SS for light colors. I have tested on white and tan; it works best on white.
