One of the trickiest parts of making any quilt is selecting the fabrics...selecting fabrics for your National Park quilt can be even trickier. Note that I never said hard. It's just tricky. Use these Scale Finders to help you envision the scale.

Cut out the center section, and place it on top of possible fabrics to help determine if a fabric will be a good option.

For the Trees Scale Finder, use this for blocks with smaller trees (like Mt Rainier) as opposed to larger trees (like Redwoods).

This area should measure 1"
